



COVID-19 VACCINATION ROLLOUT

NCR Best Practices Playbook



Introduction

The Philippine National COVID Vaccination Deployment rollout commenced in March 1, 2021. The initial shipment of the vaccines from Sinovac and Oxford-Astra Zeneca were distributed all over the country during the first few weeks of the rollout. The deliveries of additional vaccines, namely Pfizer–BioNTech, Sputnik V, Janssen, Covaxin, and Moderna, are to follow suit.

Following a spike of cases in the National Capital Region, as well as the limited supply of vaccines in the international market, the vaccine cluster within the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) implemented a reprioritization strategy for the country.

Introduction

The exit strategy, dubbed as “NCR Plus 8” aims to prioritize the deployment of vaccines in areas reporting high numbers of cases, and among groups most at risk of getting the disease.

Metro Manila, Bulacan, Cavite, Rizal, Laguna, Pampanga, Batangas, Metro Cebu, and Metro Davao make up areas part of "NCR Plus 8, as these areas were among those reporting high infection rates and were economically critical to the country.

This reprioritization aims to achieve “population protection” for the abovementioned locations by November 2021.

Playbook Objectives

The vaccination program output across NCR Plus should be ramped up once the supplies of vaccine increase. With the target of achieving population protection by November, as well as decreasing wastage when the deliveries arrive, the Local Government Units should utilize strategies and mechanisms that will help increase their vaccine utilization.

This playbook collates best practices being implemented in the National Capital Region. Activities geared towards registration, demand generation, vaccine administration & throughput, and other unique practices across LGUs are going to be discussed.

A4 VACCINE ROLLOUT AND PARTNERSHIP
